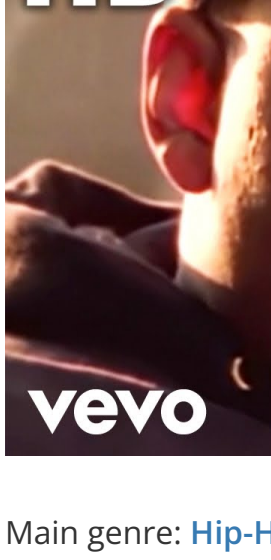

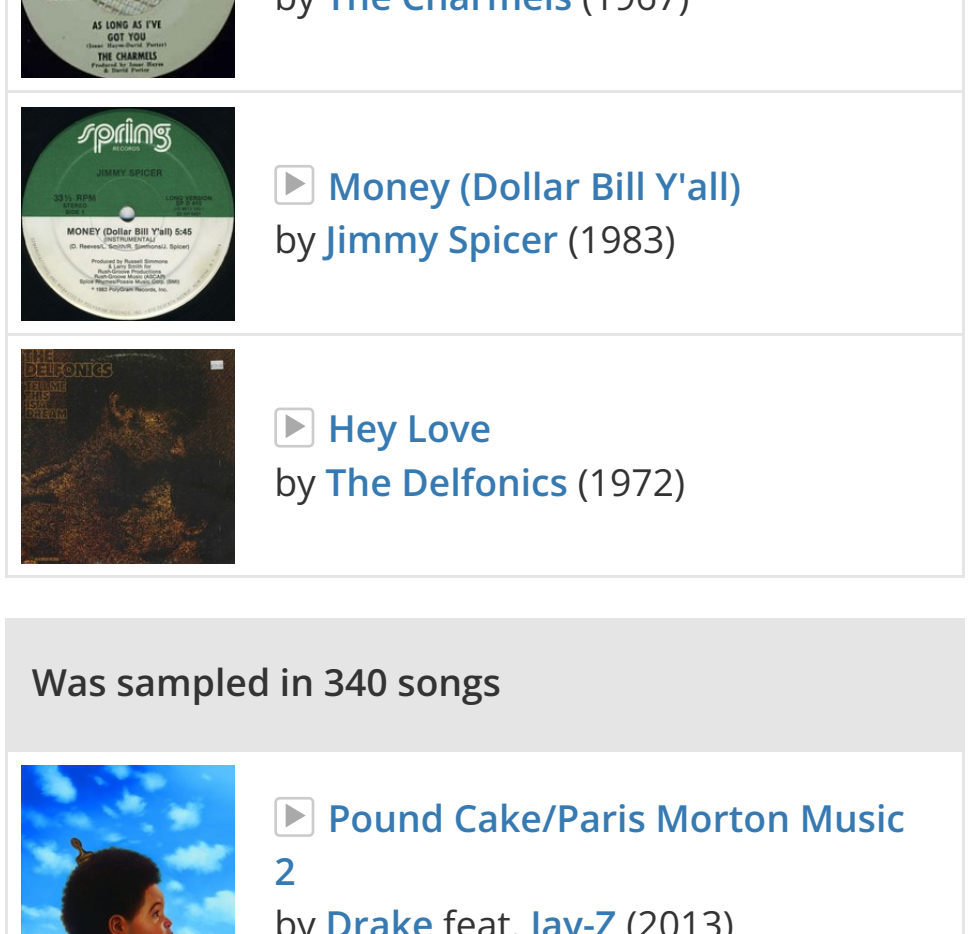

5 According to Raekwon, "cream" was neighborhood slang for money, originating from Tom & Jerry cartoons in which Jerry (the cat) would slap Tom (the mouse) with whipped cream during fights over food. In this way, "cream" became a word used when trying to get money or fighting over it.

The acronym (Cash Rules Everything Around Me) was coined by an associate of Method Man's called Raider Ruckus, since assigning meaning to words in this way was a popular practice with graffiti artists at the time.

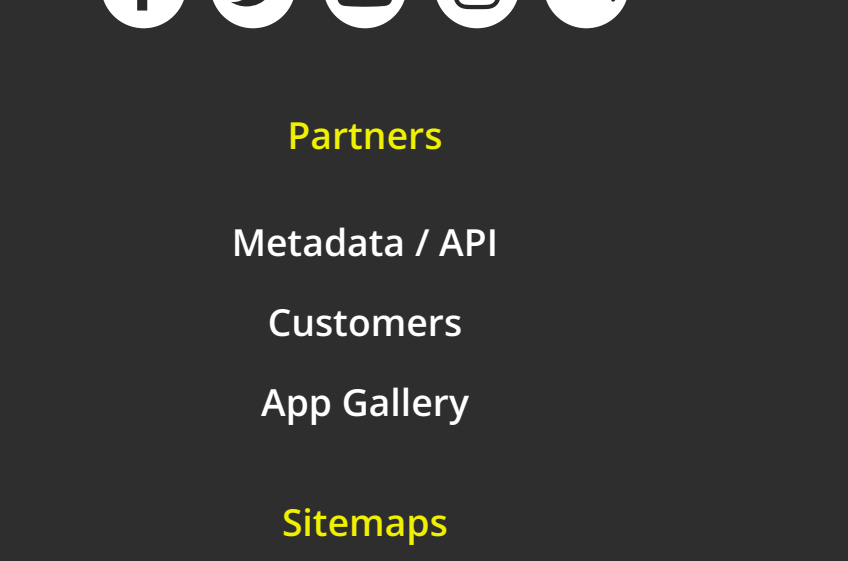
3 Soul artist Isaac Hayes was a co-producer on the Charmels' cut 'As Long As I Got You,' the song which RZA sampled for the instrumental to 'C.R.E.A.M.' When RZA finally got to meet his music hero, he told him about the Charmels song Hayes had worked on from decades ago, and how he'd used it for a Wu-Tang track. Not expecting a reaction from such an obscure song, RZA was surprised to hear Hayes sing the entire piano melody off the top of his head as if it were yesterday.

2 Inspectah Deck wrote his verse for 'C.R.E.A.M.' whilst standing on front of a building "with crack in my sock," though it wasn't the only verse he penned. Both he and Raekwon originally had two verses each on the track, though their contributions were halved to fit a more radio-friendly runtime. Inspectah Deck said the verse which made the final edit is a combination of "the first part of the first verse and the second part of the second verse"; as for whether we would hear the unused lines, he joked that they'd be compiled into a poetry book and released after he died.
